

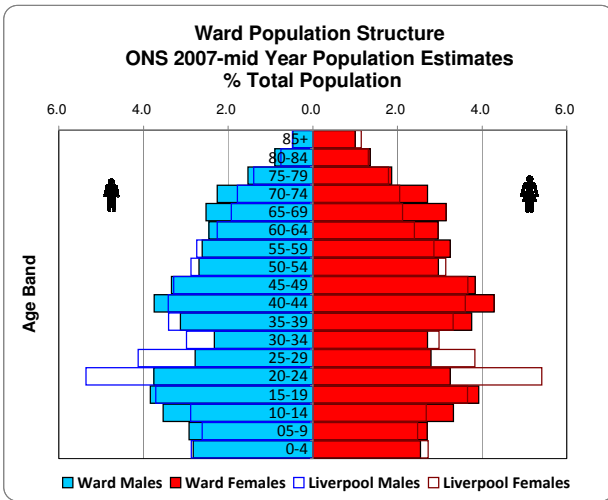

Ward Summary

Belle Vale is amongst the third most deprived quintile in Liverpool. More than 40% of its dwellings consist of social housing which is higher than for Liverpool.

Life expectancy at birth for both males and females is lower than nationally but higher for males when compared to the Liverpool average.

The birth rate per 1,000 females aged 15-44 is comparable to the Liverpool average.

GCSE attainment is below the Liverpool average with the percentage of students gaining 5 A* - C grades amongst the lowest in the city.

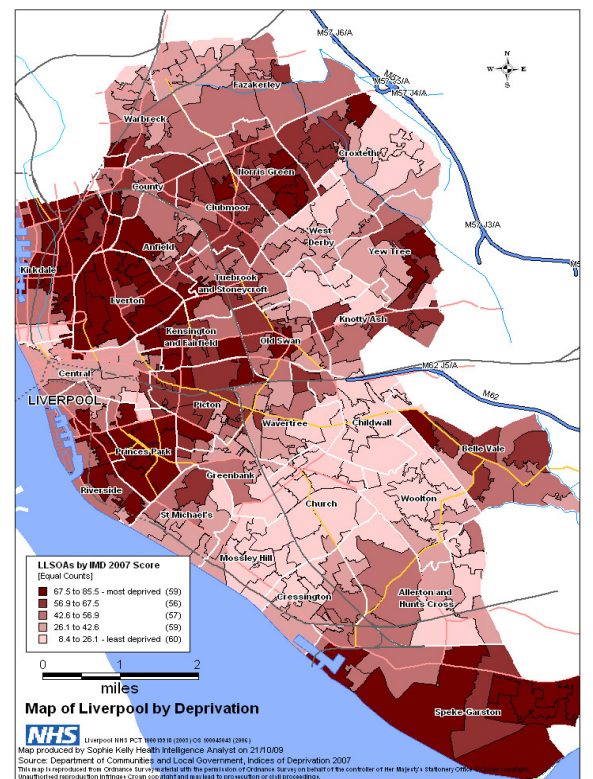
Rates of domestic burglaries, robberies and vehicle crime are all lower than for Liverpool.

According to the 2001 Census, 28% of residents have a limiting long term illness which is higher than for Liverpool.

The percentage of claimants on job seeker's allowance is comparable to the Liverpool average whilst rates of worklessness and the proportion in receipt of incapacity benefit are higher.

For persons of all ages, Belle Vale's all cause mortality rates are lower than average for Liverpool but higher for all circulatory diseases and all cancer mortality. This is also the case for premature mortality.

For persons of all ages, Belle Vale's coronary heart disease and stroke mortality rates are above the Liverpool average.

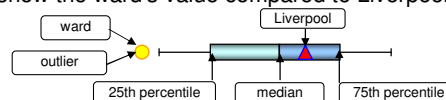
