

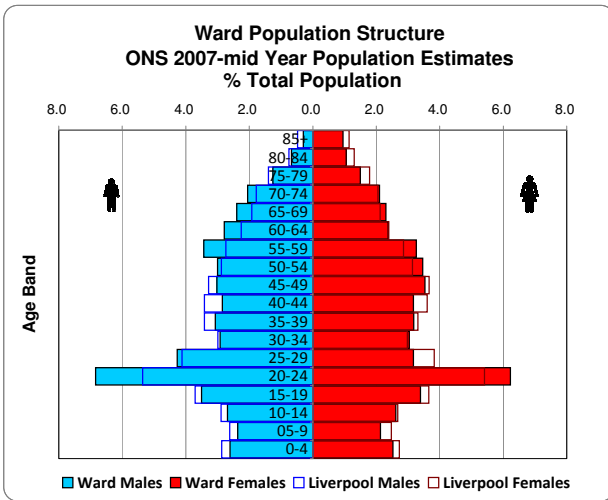
# LIVERPOOL WARD HEALTH PROFILE 2009

### Ward Summary

Kirkdale is amongst the most deprived quintile in Liverpool. 45% of its dwellings consist of social housing.

Life expectancy at birth for both males and females is amongst the lowest in Liverpool.

The birth rate per 1,000 females aged 15-44 is higher than the Liverpool average.

GCSE attainment i.e. the percentage of students gaining 5 A - C grades is lower than the Liverpool average.

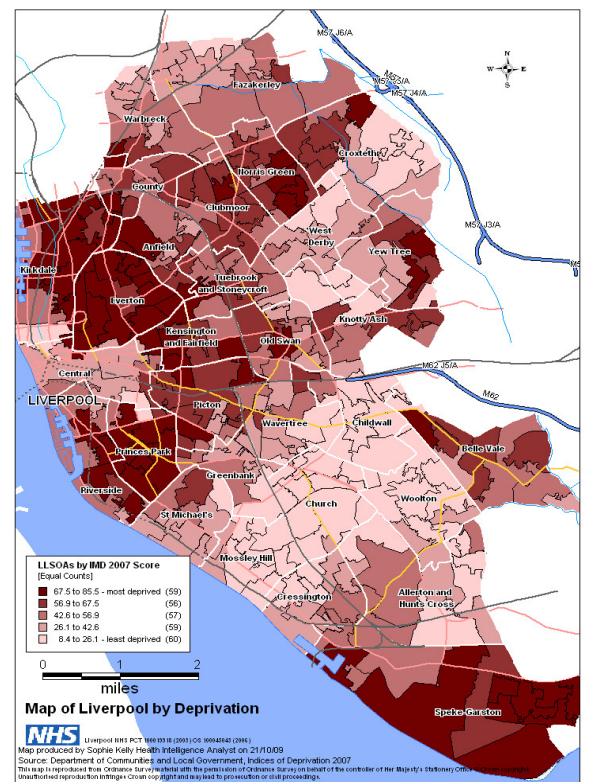
Rates of vehicle crime and robberies are higher than for Liverpool whilst rates of domestic burglaries are comparable to the Liverpool average.

According to the 2001 Census, 31% of residents have a limiting long term illness which is amongst the highest in Liverpool.

The proportions of claimants on incapacity benefits and job seekers allowance are higher than for Liverpool as a whole as are rates of worklessness.

Kirkdale's all age all cause mortality for males and females is amongst the highest in Liverpool. This is also the case for premature mortality. Kirkdale also experiences higher all age cancer mortality, particularly in males.

For persons of all ages, Kirkdale's mortality rates for coronary heart disease and stroke are higher than the Liverpool average.

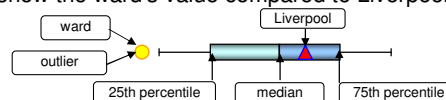
