

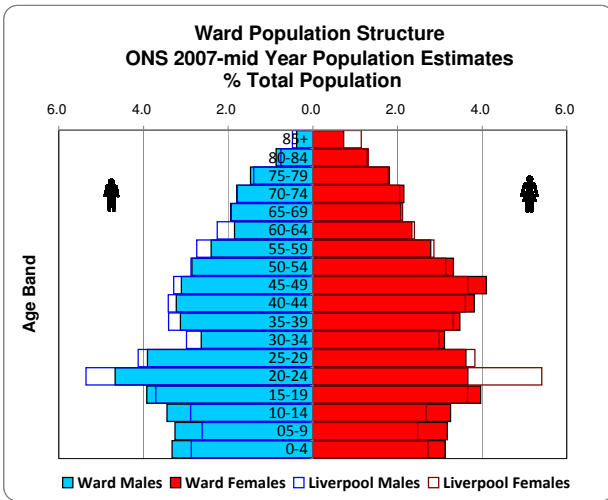
# LIVERPOOL WARD HEALTH PROFILE 2009

### Ward Summary

Norris Green is amongst the most deprived quintile in Liverpool. 54% of its dwellings consist of social housing.

Life expectancy at birth for both males and females is lower than for Liverpool and nationally.

The birth rate per 1,000 females aged 15-44 is higher than the Liverpool average.

GCSE attainment i.e. the percentage of students gaining 5 A - C grades is lower than the Liverpool average.

Rates of domestic burglaries, and vehicle crime are all lower than for Liverpool whilst rates of robberies are comparable to the city average.

According to the 2001 Census, 28% of residents have a limiting long term illness which higher than the Liverpool average.

The proportions of claimants on incapacity benefits and job seekers allowance are higher than for Liverpool as are rates of worklessness.

For males and females of all ages, Norris Green experiences higher mortality than Liverpool due to all causes, all cancers and all circulatory diseases. This is also the case for premature mortality, with rates for males from circulatory disease and cancer amongst the highest in the city.

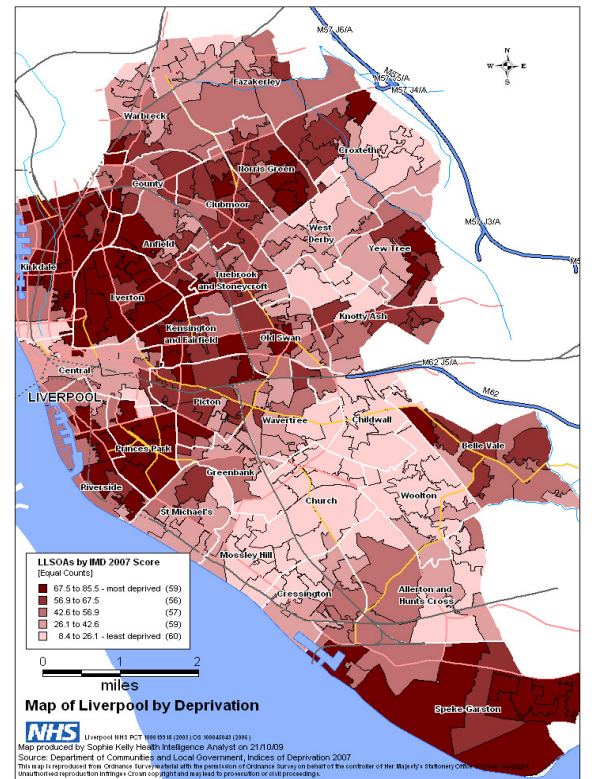
For persons of all ages, Norris Green experiences higher mortality from coronary heart disease when compared to the Liverpool average but relatively lower stroke mortality. For females of all ages, coronary heart disease mortality is amongst the highest in the city.

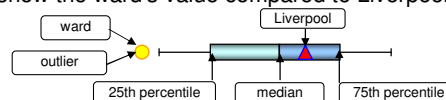
