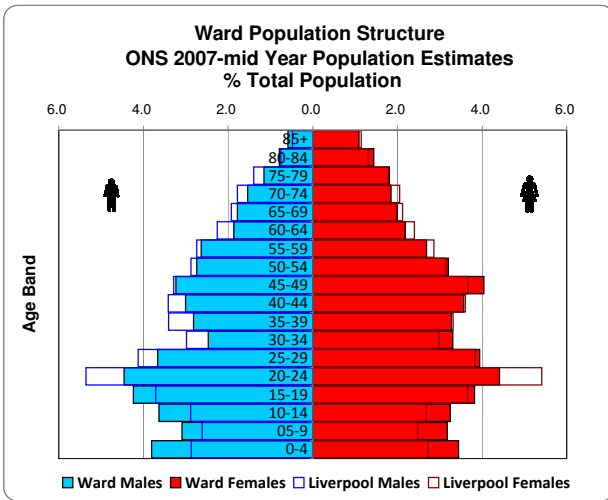


LIVERPOOL WARD HEALTH PROFILE 2009

Ward Summary

Speke-Garston is amongst the most deprived quintile in Liverpool. 46% of its dwellings consist of social housing which is amongst the highest in Liverpool.

Life expectancy at birth for both males and females is lower than the Liverpool average.

The birth rate per 1,000 females aged 15-44 is amongst the highest in Liverpool.

GCSE attainment i.e. the percentage of students gaining 5 A* - C grades is amongst the lowest in the city.

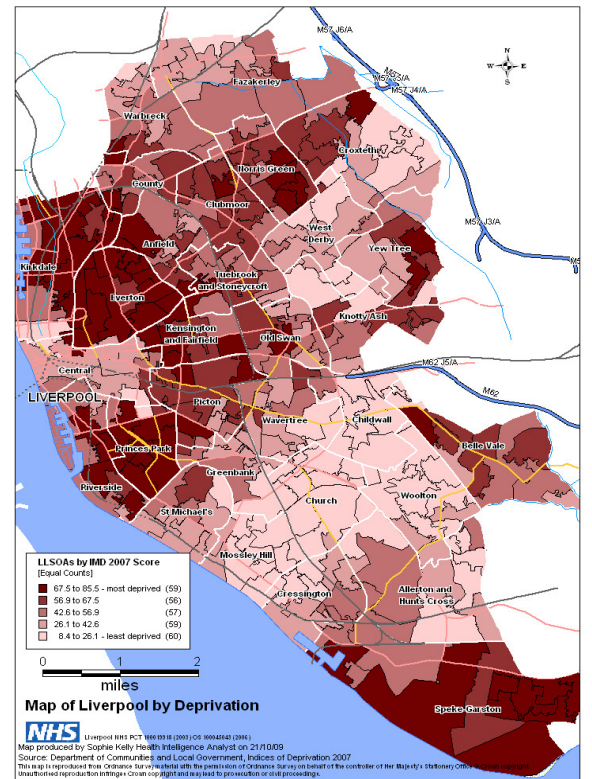
Rates of domestic burglaries and robberies are amongst the lowest in Liverpool whilst vehicle crime is amongst the highest.

According to the 2001 Census, 29% of residents have a limiting long term illness which is amongst the highest in Liverpool.

The proportions of claimants on incapacity benefits and job seekers allowance are amongst the highest in the city as are rates of worklessness.

For males and females, Speke-Garston experiences higher all age mortality than Liverpool due to all causes, all circulatory diseases and all cancers. This is also the case for premature mortality with circulatory disease in females being the highest in the city.

For females of all ages, Speke-Garston's mortality from coronary heart disease is the highest in the city whilst stroke mortality is lower than the Liverpool average.

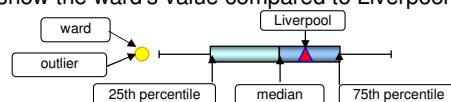
