

NHS Walk-in Centres in Liverpool

Nurse-led healthcare advice, information and treatment if you have a minor injury or illness, open every day – *no appointment necessary...*

There are four NHS Walk-in Centres in Liverpool providing fast and convenient access to NHS advice and treatment.

The Walk-in Centres are a Nurse-led service. You can see an experienced nurse for advice, assessment, information and treatment of minor illnesses and injuries. In some cases a prescription may be issued or an X-ray requested by the nurse.

The Walk-in Centres are conveniently open 365 days a year from early until late. The service is confidential and you do not need an appointment – just walk in.

The Walk-in Centres work alongside other health care services; they do not take the place of GPs or hospital services but aim to provide an alternative NHS service for minor illnesses and injuries.

What services do we offer?

The type of problems dealt with include:

- Coughs and colds
- Sore throats
- Ear ache
- Sprains and strains
- Cuts and bruises
- Rashes
- Bites and stings
- Sunburn
- Headlice
- Stomach upsets
- Vomiting and diarrhoea
- Indigestion and constipation
- Contraception advice
(including emergency contraception)
- Chlamydia testing (under 25s)
- General health advice and information
